This Month's Feature

Toys 'n' Tucker is a long-standing initiative of Anglicare Sydney which aims to share the joy of Christmas and demonstrate God's love by providing food and gifts for those who would otherwise go without.

Churches, schools, businesses and community groups collect and donate new toys and non-perishable food which are then picked up and taken to the Anglicare warehouse in Villawood. Everything is sorted and packed into food and gift hampers by a team of dedicated volunteers. The hampers are then distributed to people through Anglicare's emergency relief and family support programs and by local churches. These families are all known by Anglicare and/or local churches, and known to be in need. While the food hampers provided are virtually identical in content, the toy hampers are packed by volunteers who are provided with the age and sex of each child in the family. In 2015, 2820 food hampers and 2617 toy hampers were distributed to families all over Sydney who were struggling financially.

At St Philips we have been collecting food and toys since August this year! However as well as donating goods at church you can buy a hamper online. All the funds will go directly to purchasing necessary food and toy items to be given to those who need it most.

Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.



SITE DEVELOPMENT

A letter outlining the Extraordinary General Meeting was discussed and edited for translation and distribution to all services. Key to this was ensuring clarity for all members of the congregations as to how the next steps of enquiry need to be assessed.

Quotes were received for a site survey and this will take place in November.

OTHER MATTERS

Bank accounts: With the closure of GAB, all Church investment accounts have been moved to another financial institution, after thorough investigation and comparisons were made in relation to interest rates and accessibility needs. The wardens were thanked for all their hard work in relation to this matter.

2017 budget: Initial discussions and planning. CMS missions giving to increase in 2017 to \$13,000. Extra day of adminsitative assistance to be included, particularly for work with Chinese translation and data entry. These items will not greatly affect the budget for 2017.
